

ILLINOIS MERIT SCHOLAR AWARD

The purpose of the Illinois Merit Scholar Award is to motivate individual Illinois Business Professionals of America members and advisors to learn as much as possible about the history, tradition, programs, and activities of their organization.

The Illinois Merit Scholar Exam will be offered as an Open Contest at SLC. Any dues paid Illinois member or advisor attending the State Leadership Conference may earn the Illinois Merit Scholar Award by achieving a minimum of 90 percent on an objective test. Exam questions will be taken from the Illinois Fact Sheet. The Merit Test has been revised to reflect a greater emphasis on data relating to the Torch Awards, the significance of the Emblem, etc. Students will still be required to memorize the names of key individuals, however. This test is not part of the competitive events program. The Illinois Merit Scholar Award is part of the special recognition programs offered to Illinois members.

Persons achieving Illinois Merit Scholar status will be awarded pins signifying their accomplishment. Once an Illinois Merit Scholar--always one. Illinois Merit Scholars do not take the test in subsequent years.
